BINGO REVENUE MODEL 1 YEAR REVIEW RESULTS

Please attend an information session to learn more about the results of the analysis of the first year of the Bingo Revenue Model for pooling bingo halls in Ontario.

In May 2007, the Registrar of Alcohol and Gaming implemented a new revenue sharing model for pooling Bingo halls in Ontario. The new Bingo Revenue Model was the result of detailed analysis conducted by HLT Advisory Inc., which included considerable consultation with Bingo industry stakeholders. At the time of the implementation of the new Bingo Revenue Model, the Registrar of Alcohol and Gaming committed to a review of the new model after the first year of its implementation. HLT Advisory Inc. was engaged to conduct the one year review. The results of that review are ready to be shared with the industry.
